For 25 + years Larry Lorenzo has traveled across the country entertaining others as a disc jockey. During this time he has crossed paths with many people, and many women. Lorenzo uses his experiences as the inspiration for the wild tales of *Behind the Bar Room Doors*.

Behind the Bar Room Doors tells of the exploits of Ricardo a very handsome and very popular DJ from Philadelphia. Ricardo travels across the country entertaining crowds, and meeting new women. Always the center of attention as a DJ, Ricardo uses his Italian charm, control of the music, and his ability to dance to woo the women of his choice. Unfortunately for Ricardo, sometimes the women he gets involved with give him a little more than he had bargained for.

Behind the Bar Room Doors is organized into 21 short tales, filled with smooth lines, smoother moves, and a good dose of humor. The tales are tastefully presented with the physical action being more romantic than erotic. Plenty of great songs are referenced in the book, and the reader will probably find themselves rushing to their CD collection after each tale. Partly good recruitment material for the disc jockey profession, *Behind the Bar Room Doors* also serves as an illustration of the old adage "Be careful what you wish for you just might get it".
